Attendance:

- The meeting began at approximately 11:02 a.m.
 - Present: Nelmark, Teiken, Fowler, Benjamin, Mills

Approval of Agenda & Minutes from the February 11, 2026, meeting:

- Motion to approve February 11, 2026, meeting minutes: Teiken, Second: Fowler
 - Unanimous approval – roll call vote.

Investment Team Updates:

- Call for Applications:
 - 16 applications received; expecting a rush of applications as we approach March 10.
 - Successful webinar with 61 participants, 93 registered
 - FAQ's updated with 18 questions
 - Second call for applications will launch mid-April
- Closings: *Moving at the speed of the applicant*
 - Enterprise – in final structuring stages, and awaiting final closing documents
 - NDC - in final stages, and targeting mid-March or sometime in April
- Hiring:
 - New investment officer interviews
- Risk Rating Tool Updates:
 - The risk spread is an output of the risk rating tool, included in MnCIFA's lending manual. Initially contemplated with 10 indicators, now updated and iterated with 8 indicators. Each indicator receives a score between 1 to 5, with 5 being the most amount of risk. The final risk rating score is a value of all of the average value of scores combined. That average score then determines the risk rating and risk spread.
 - Lessons learned from current portfolio:
 - Complexity of risk, projects, and project finance capital stacks
 - Need to price risks associated with the market, technology, stage of enterprise, and the ability for project to execute
 - Moving from 8 to 9 scored indicators
 - Removing 2 indicators, adding three indicators

- Scoring thresholds, ratings, and risk spreads remain unchanged

Finance Team Updates:

- Payment Portal is now live
 - \$92,763.37 received as of 3/4/2026 (GMHF, 3561 Minnehaha)
- Invoicing:
 - 4 projects in the repayment phase of their loans
- Loan Origination and Management System:
 - Vendor selected: Fundingo
 - All finalists notified of selection process
 - Actively preparing for start of implementation (May/June 2026)
- Quarterly Meetings:
 - Conducted 4 quarterly meetings (as of 3/5/2026)
 - 3561 Minnehaha was impacted by ICE surge
- Procedures:
 - Drafting procedures for quarterly reviews and annual reviews
- Hiring:
 - Scheduling final interviews for Loan Servicing and Portfolio Manager

Other Discussion:

- Kari Groth Swan updated the committee that both bills have been approved, and she will be working with Senator Xion on any changes and appropriation language. A strategy is being developed, particularly for the house, and are looking for a Republican to possibly carry the bill as both are tied. Hoping to have a discussion with Representative Igo.
